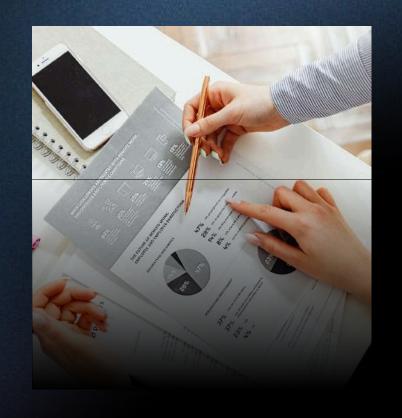
INTRODUCTION
