HOW MUCH DOES UDACITY COST?



Udacity is not a free platform, and its cost is often a deciding factor for learners who are wondering, is *Udacity worth it* for the investment.

- Nanodegree programs typically cost \$399/month, but Udacity often provides discounts and bundles.
- On average, a full Nanodegree takes 3-6 months, bringing the total cost to around \$1,000-\$2,000.
- Occasionally, Udacity offers scholarships and free introductory courses.
