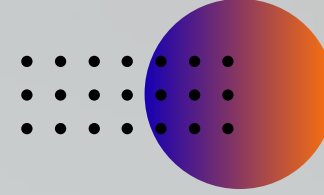
Tracking Without Micromanaging Employees

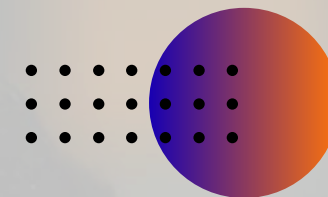
WHY PRODUCTIVITY TRACKING IS IMPORTANT IN MODERN WORKPLACES

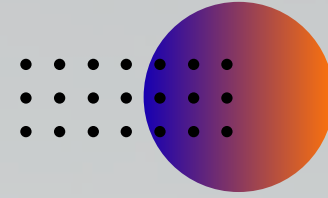
